There will be no registration on the competition day.

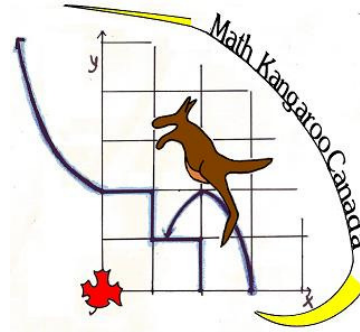
Individual and overall contest results will be available online.

2010 Math Kangaroo Contest

Contest History

The Contest-Game “Math Kangaroo” originated in France in 1991 and quickly became very popular among students in many European countries. Several years later, the association “Kangourou sans frontières” was founded and it now organises the event. The contest’s main purpose is to promote mathematical thinking and stimulate an interest in math, by providing students with an opportunity to compare their abilities against the abilities of other students, from different countries around the world. In the past several years, the geography of the participating countries has been extended outside Europe, to USA, Brazil, Mexico, Canada, etc. In 2009, more than 5,000,000 students from 41 countries played the game, world-wide.
